

CALDER DRIFT CAMPSITE

BOOKING CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION

Prices are as per the current year's price list on the website. Prices are reviewed 1 April each year, and will be applied to all advance bookings received prior to 1 April.

A deposit of £25 (or full fee if less than this) is to be paid with this booking form and an email will be sent to confirm the booking. Any balance of payment is to be made one week before the booking based on estimated numbers attending and any balance due to changes in numbers to be settled at the end of occupation. Refunds if applicable will be made within 14 days of the end of occupation.

For a day or evening booking with no associated camping then no deposit is required but fees will be settled on the numbers attending determined according to the checklist returned with the site keys.

If the camping areas used are found to be damaged an appropriate charge may be raised to cover any reinstatement costs.

An administration fee of £10 will be made if the booking is cancelled after the confirmation email has been sent out, this will be deducted from the deposit already paid, unless due to inclement weather to be agreed with the Booking Secretary.

Archery/Air Rifle Shooting – Permit/Qualifications of the Range officer, in accordance with POR, are to be forwarded as a pdf by email to the booking secretary for future reference together with a copy of the Risk Assessment. (unless the Permit/ Qualifications have already been supplied) before keys are collected.

Checklist to be completed and returned at the end of the booking.

Site Rules should be downloaded from the website.

Non Scouting Organisations need to supply a copy of suitable insurance cover for the period of occupation of the campsite as they will not be covered by our Scout Insurance.

Site Security – It is important that the padlocks are not removed from the gates, they should be refastened on the gate/chain/post as other people have access to the road but not our site gate and if our site gate padlock gets put on the wrong gate etc then they will be unable to access the road.

Dogs are not allowed on the campsite, except guide dogs, which will need to be notified to the booking secretary before they come on site.
